A major 6.9 magnitude earthquake occurred in central Philippines on 30 September 2025 (local time). The meeting hall of the church in Bogo City, and many of the saints' homes have been severely damaged. Saints are currently residing in makeshift tents as temporary shelters, and power and water supply have been disrupted and are unavailable.

Attached to this letter is additional information sent from the church in Bogo City with more details about the situation there.

Several saints in New Zealand have contacted us to see if we can help facilitate an easier way for offerings from New Zealand be sent to the Philippines.

MESSAGE FROM THE CHURCH IN BOGO CITY

Dear Brothers and Sisters,

Greetings in the name of our Lord and Savior, Jesus Christ.

We would like to inform you that Bogo City has recently experienced a 6.9 magnitude earthquake. As a result, the commercial district has been severely damaged, and most of the homes of the saints have suffered significant structural damage. Due to this, many of our brothers and sisters are currently residing in makeshift tents as temporary shelters.

As of the time of this post, power and water supply have been disrupted and are unavailable. Furthermore, potable water is in short supply, posing a challenge to the immediate needs of the community.

The 4-storey meeting hall, which serves as a vital center for our meetings, has also been severely damaged, and all full-time serving ones have been evacuated for their safety.

In addition to the initial earthquake, multiple aftershocks of varying intensity are still being observed in the area. Please continue to pray for the safety and well-being of all our brothers and sisters.
